This Consent of Candidate must be filed at the same time as the Financial Disclosure Form and Nomination by Party Committee are filed.

Each candidate for office in the **General Election on November 3, 2020** must file this Consent of Candidate and a Financial Disclosure form along with the Nomination by Party Committee form with the filing officer in order to authorize the printing of his or her name on the General Election ballot.

For all candidates, except Justices of the Peace, **this form is due in the Office of the Secretary of State between Monday April 27, 2020 and no later than Monday, August 17, 2020 by 5 p.m.** You **MUST** file this Consent of Candidate form at the same time the Nomination by Party Committee form is filed. **(Justice of the Peace candidates have different forms and must file their nomination by party committee with the town or city clerk by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, August 14, 2020.)**

Please complete this form carefully. This form is required by law to establish exactly how each candidate's name, town of residence, and district will appear on the ballot. The law also requires that each candidate provide us with a mailing address. You may include initials or nicknames in your name; however titles cannot appear on the ballot. It will be most helpful if you limit your name including spaces to no more than 24 characters.

NOTICE OF MEETINGS: 17 V.S.A. §2383

Notice of the date, time, and location of the meeting must be provided to all committee members at least 5 days prior to the meeting by the chair of the appropriate committee. Notice must include which offices nominations will be made for. A copy of the notice must be filed with the statement of nomination.

WHEN TO FILE: 17 V.S.A. § 2386

No sooner than **MONDAY, APRIL 27, 2020** and no later than **5:00 p.m. on MONDAY, AUGUST 17, 2020**

WHERE TO FILE: 17 V.S.A. § 2387

Major party committee nominations must be filed with the Secretary of State, 128 State Street, Montpelier, VT 05633 (except for Justice of the Peace).

Note: Under Vermont law, "filed" means "deposited in the regularly maintained office of the official with whom the filing is to be made." 17 V.S.A. § 2103(13)

FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE FORMS: 17 V.S.A. §2414

Candidates for statewide non-federal office, state senate, and state representative must file the State Ethics Commission financial disclosure form along with their statements of nomination and consent of candidate. Financial Disclosure forms are not required for County Office candidates.

Statewide non-federal candidates must also file a copy of the most recent IRS Form 1040 in accordance with 17 V.S.A. § 2414(c)*. *Please note that the law allows certain information to be redacted.

CONSENT FORM: 17 V.S.A. § 2385(d)

A Consent of Candidate form must be filed at the same time as your Party Committee Nomination. **YOUR NAME WILL NOT BE PRINTED ON THE BALLOT** if you fail to file a consent form.

APPLICABILITY OF MAJOR PARTY NOMINATIONS- 17 V.S.A. §2381

Nominations by major party committees will only apply in the case of a death, removal or withdrawal of a candidate, or the failure of the major political party to nominate a candidate by primary.
