

## Defining Ethics:

Ethics credits must be clearly delineated on the certificate or in the program and be approved by the American Psychological Association, the Vermont Psychological Association, or the Vermont Board of Psychological Examiners.

If an individual claims CEU's not approved by the American Psychological Association, the Vermont Psychological Association or the Vermont Board of Psychological Examiners, the material must adhere to the American Psychological Association Ethical Principles of Psychologists and Code of Conduct (<http://www.apa.org/ethics/code/>) or the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards Code of Conduct ([https://c.ymcdn.com/sites/asppb.site-ym.com/resource/resmgr/Guidelines/Code\\_of\\_Conduct\\_Updated\\_2013.pdf](https://c.ymcdn.com/sites/asppb.site-ym.com/resource/resmgr/Guidelines/Code_of_Conduct_Updated_2013.pdf)). In addition, the applicant must briefly document the specific principle, standard or section of the relevant code to which the CEU applies.
