Council of Applied Master's Program in Psychology (CAMPP) Policy

Because the Council of Applied Master's Programs in Psychology (CAMPP) no longer offers membership or educational review services, the Board will disregard 26 V.S.A. Section 3001(10)(C) and the last sentence of Rule 3.3 of the Administrative Rules of the Board of Psychological Examiners (Rules) (i.e., strike the following in Rule 3.3: "To qualify under this rule, the psychology training program must be offered by a full member of the Council of Applied Master's Programs in Psychology (CAMPP)."). To qualify for a license as a master's degree level psychologist, applicants must demonstrate completion of a master's degree program that meets the requirements set forth in 26 V.S.A. Section 3001(10)(A) and Rules 3.4 through 3.9, as well as fulfill the other regulatory obligations for licensure. The Board will accept transcripts through inactivity of CAMPP.
